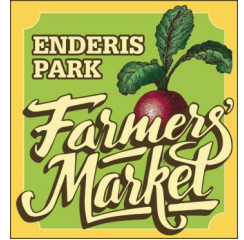

CRIME AND SAFETY REMINDERS: Tips to Prevent Crimes of Opportunity

Open windows

When not home or sleeping, either shut and lock windows or install stoppers or pins so that the windows only opens 6 inches, thereby preventing screens from being cut for easy entry.

Open doors

Lock doors at all times, even when working in the yard -- you could be in the front and if a back door is open, it only takes minutes for someone to enter and steal a purse, phone, electronic device etc., especially if you live on an alley.

Lighting

Leave porch and garage lights on all through the night -- a well-lit property deters crime!

Garage

Install dead bolt locks and chain bikes, lawn mowers and snow blowers to the wall with an eye bolt. Close garage doors when not in sight of the garage door -- another opportunity to steal bikes, equipment etc.

Auto theft

If you park on the street or in the alley, use a steering wheel club, especially if you have an older model vehicle or a Dodge or Chrysler product

4th of July Celebration

Wednesday, July 4 | 8:30 AM to 11:30 AM

Schedule of events:

8:30 AM: Parade departs from Mother of Good Counsel parking lot. What a great opportunity for children to show off their creativity by decorating their bikes, scooters, wagons or strollers or creating a red, white, and blue costume.

9 AM: Arrive at Enderis Park to register for a trophy and receive free ice cream.

9 AM to 11:30 AM: Activities include a flag-raising ceremony, American trivia quiz, (temporary) tattooing and face painting, a band concert with Americana Sing-a-Long, children's games with prizes and tours of an MPD District 7 squad car. The Watermelon Eating Contest is open to all ages and prizes will be awarded to winners in each age category. The event concludes with a water balloon toss and a display by Milwaukee Fire Department.

9 AM to 11:30 AM: EPNA will be selling brats, hot dogs, chips, and beverages generously donated by Sentry on 71st & Lisbon.

Break down tables and clean up the park: 2 to 3 volunteers are needed at 12 PM
