WOW! AGAIN

Thanks to a generous donation from Betty Novak, in memory of her father, a World War II Veteran, and her family who grew up playing ball on the Enderis ball diamond, PLUS a grant from the city*, PLUS labor for installation contributed by MPS Recreation Department, PLUS membership funds from the Association, PLUS the pennies donated at this year's egg hunt, we will be installing at the playfield this summer two new playground features: a funnelball hoop on the asphalt section inside the running/walking track, and a climbing apparatus nearby.

PLUS, we will be giving out two dozen 10" and 13" rubber playground balls at our upcoming concerts and July 4th celebration.

MILWAUKEE MAKEOVER MATCHING GRANTS: \$2,000*

As a member of the Milwaukee Healthy Neighborhood Initiative, we have the opportunity to award five to seven matching grants of \$2,000 each to residents of Enderis, Lenox Heights and Alameda Place who submit proposals that will make the strongest visual improvements to the curb appeal of their homes. Those selected will be paired with local architects who are contributing their ideas to the projects within the budgets of the home owner. They will also be a part of a citywide event stretching over eight other neighborhoods that celebrates this effort in our city.

Deadline for submission of the application is May 20th, 2010. Financing for the homeowner portion of the cost may be available.
